In compliance with Section 2279 of the California Agricultural Code, I hereby submit the Placer County Annual Crop Report for 1982.

This report represents only the gross value of agricultural products and does not represent net returns to the producers.

The gross production value for 1982 was \$50,220,100, a decrease of \$3,722,400 from 1981.

Inclement weather which reduced acreages and yield of many crops, coupled with decreased prices of some crops, were the major causes for this decrease.

The cattle industry again was the leading industry followed by the turkey and rice industries.

I wish to express my appreciation to the many firms and individuals of the agricultural industry who provided us with information which made this report possible.
